Re: Family Flicks – Free Saturday Matinees at your Library

The Family Flicks movie series will resume at 2pm on Saturday, January 7 at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS). Offered at 2pm on the first Saturday of every month, January through April, the Family Flicks series provides fun family entertainment, popcorn, and movie trivia at an affordable price—free!

The 2017 series kicks off with a screening of “Ratatouille” at 2pm on Saturday, January 7. This G-rated animated film produced by Pixar tells the story of a rat named Remy who dreams of becoming a great French chef.

On February 4, the library will kick-off the month with a screening of “The Secret Life of Pets,” a PG-rated, fast-paced, and beautifully animated comedy about the lives our pets lead after we leave for work or school each day.

On March 4, the library will show the 2008 Pixar-animated film “Wall-E,” which Time magazine called the best movie of the decade. After hundreds of lonely years of doing what he was built for, WALL-E (short for Waste Allocation Load Lifter Earth-Class) discovers a new purpose in life when he meets a sleek search robot named EVE.

The final screening of the series will feature “Zootopia” and take place on April 1. Released by Walt Disney Pictures in 2016, this is the tale of a city of anthropomorphic animals, where a

rookie bunny cop and a cynical con artist fox must work together to uncover a conspiracy. This film is rated PG for some thematic elements, action, and sometimes violent situations. That said, there are plenty of laughs and great messages about courage, empathy, tolerance, teamwork, and the dangers of reducing others to stereotypes throughout.


“Ratatouille” screens at 2pm on Saturday, January 7.
