First Step Family Support Center is providing a six-week session of *Kaleidoscope Play & Learn* at the Port Angeles Main Library of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS). This facilitated playgroup takes a whole child-whole family-whole community approach, to support families and communities where children can thrive and grow. *Kaleidoscope Play & Learn* will be held on Fridays, May 24 through June 28, at 10:15am. This play group is designed for infants and toddlers and their parents or caregivers. Babies and toddlers learn through playtime, storytime, games, and music activities with their loved ones.

Kaleidoscope Play & Learn is a program of Child Care Resources of Seattle and originated to support caregivers and families. It is intended to provide participants with resources to help families and caregivers build connections, to provide developmentally appropriate learning, and instill in children the love of—and quest for—life-long learning.

First Step Family Support Center believes that parents are their child's first teacher as well as their first emotional "home". In an effort to support parents in their crucial role, First Step offers maternity support, parenting education classes, home-visiting programs, and center-based activities so that families have the advantage in raising healthy and happy children.
