HENRY FLETCHER'S HOMESTEAD ON THE LOWER HOH RIVER TAKEN IN 1900 DURING THE FLOOD OF NOV. 1900.

The school house was across the river from the Fletcher home. John and I crossed on school mornings and again after school in one of the several Indian canoes moored to a log or huge root not far from the river's edge.

By dinner the rains began in earnest. After a few weeks of downpour the river had become so high and so full of debris, broken branches and even small trees washed in by erosion that only the grown members of the family crossed it and then only when strictly necessary.

The 20-day season was elected by the commission within the outside frame-work allowed by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, which would have allowed an additional 20 days shooting of doves.
