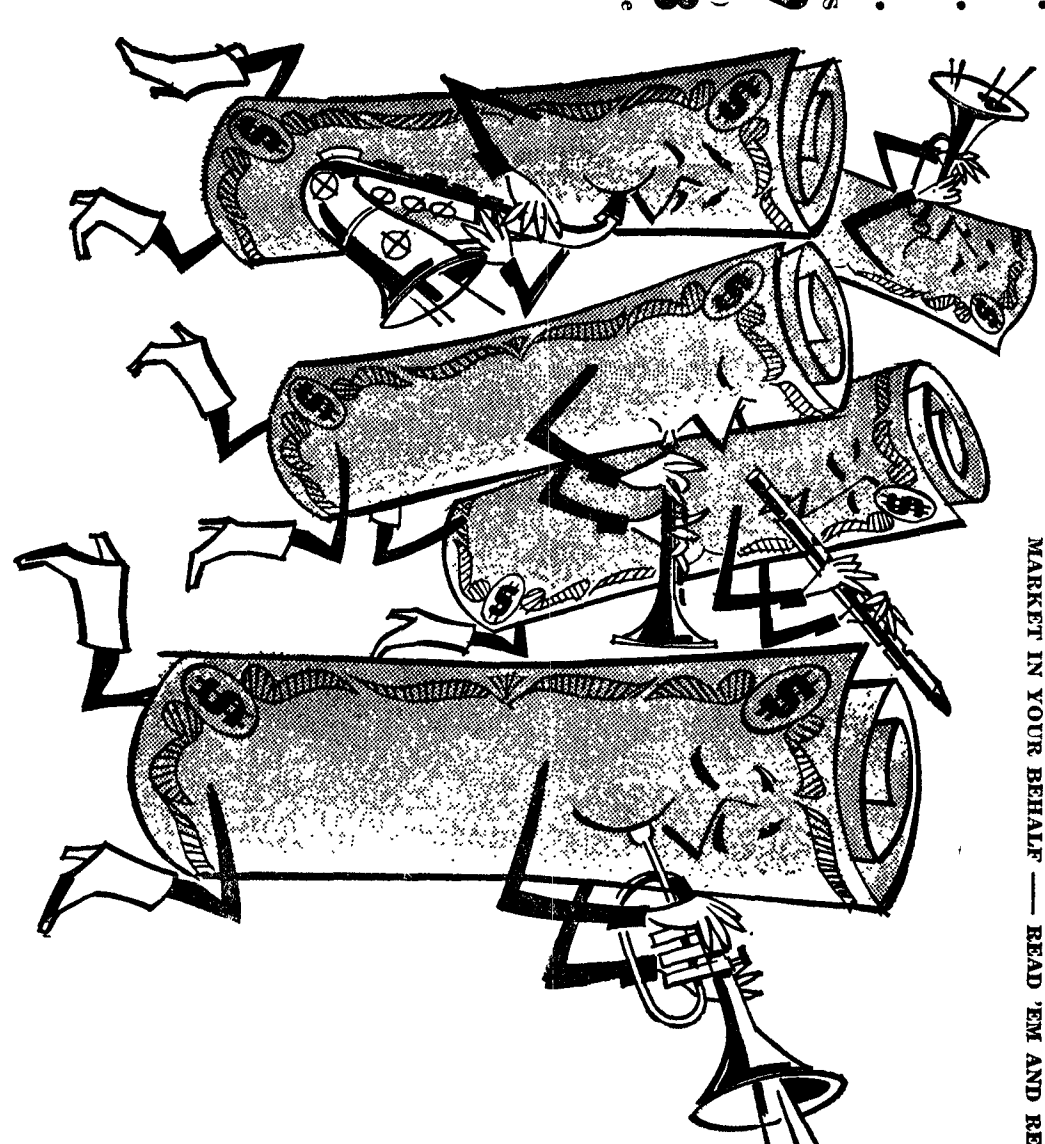

Lloyd Mallon, one of the nation's top science writers, has reports that the Soviet 'walk in space' was another big hoax to prove that point, Mallon consulted some of the foremost space and photography experts in the country.

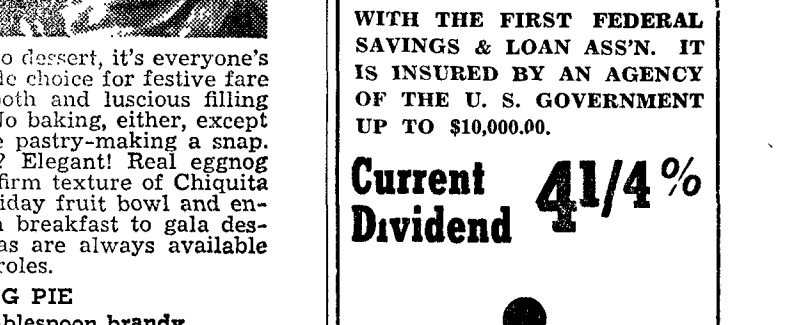
