Catholic Summer Classes

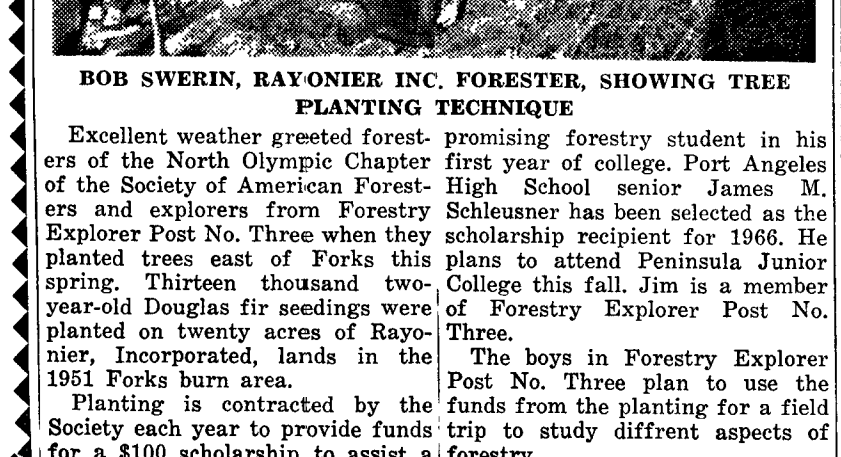
St. Anne's Mission summer religion classes for grades one through eight, will begin June 13 and run through June 17.

Why Was The Levy Originally Submitted?

1. The 1965 Legislature passed a measure requiring school districts to increase by 6% the salaries of certificated personnel teachers and administrators and to raise non-certificated personnel (janitors, secretaries, etc.) by 5%. They did NOT provide adequate funds for these increases. This placed the burden solely on each individual school district.

2. The only legal means available to the school district to raise at this time is a special levy election. This levy is made on property tax.

3. The levy being asked for is for ONE YEAR ONLY. This is no cure-all for school financial problems. If the legislature does not act to correct the situation, additional levies will undoubtedly be necessary. The only way to alleviate the situation is to store your legislators to adequately finance public schools.

4. For three years the school directors have been considering the voters for approval of a special levy. But by depleting the cash resources, by the efficient management of available funds and by cutting corners wherever possible, this was avoided. Even now the levy request is smaller than most levies requested in comparable states. Example: Moses Lake 19.5, Bremerton 15.0, North Kitsap 11.0, Vancouver 9.5, Bainbridge 22.5.

5. Because Forks had no levy, teachers salaries did not increase in comparison with those of other districts. If we cannot compete on a salary basis, we cannot hope to obtain the best teachers for your children. Your children spend from 2 to 6 hours a day under a teacher's guidance and supervision. Don't you want the most highly-qualified for the job available?
