NORTHWEST OUTWARD BOUND SCHOOL
A small band of young English sailors failed to survive the World War II sinking of a British freighter in the icy North Atlantic, and a new school was born.

The first Outward Bound school opened in 1941 at Aberdovey, Wales. Its mission was to train British seamen to endure the rigorous wartime sea duty—a similar objective of the Marine Corps' well-known sea school at San Diego, California.

The Northwest school based at the headquarters of Oregon's McKenzie River is one of 15 descendants of this first school. A student body of 200 young men ages 16 to 22 will complete a 26-day course in the second year of the school's history.
