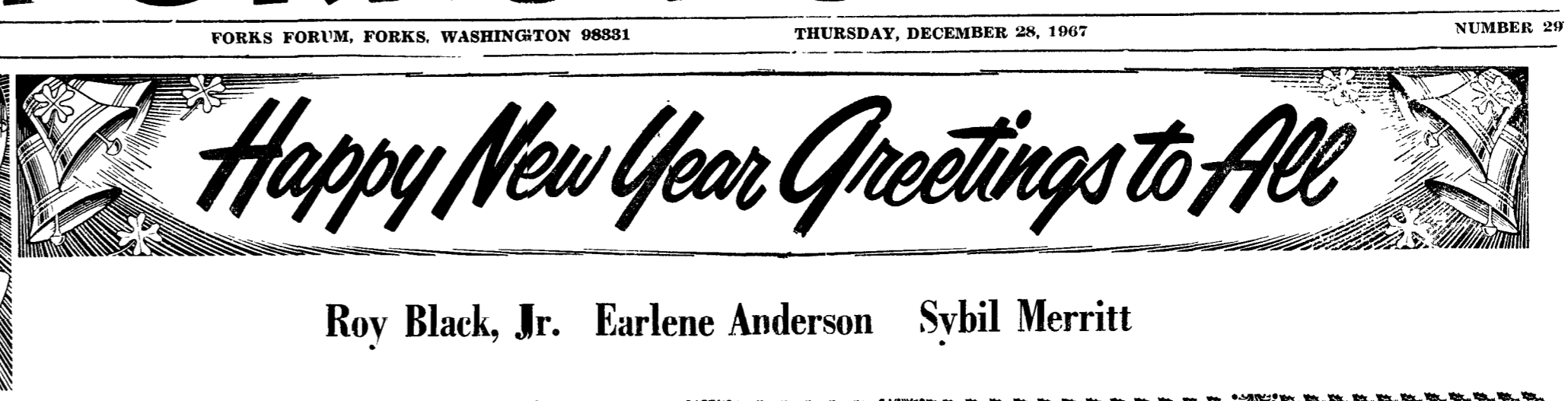

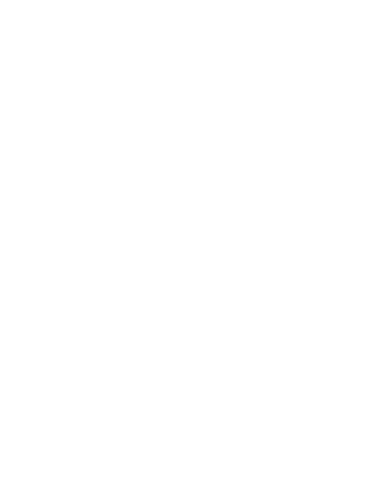

State Timber Bids Increased

306,000,000 board feet of State timber was sold for over \$10,000,000 during calendar year 1967 in the Forks District, announced E.C. Gockereil, North Olympic Area Field Supervisor of the Department of Natural Resources.

The 47 sales were bid up from \$5,821.48 to \$10,000,573 an increase of 85% over the appraised price. Average stumpage of \$32.66 per thousand board feet was up from \$25.80 in 1966 and \$29.50 in 1965.

The bulk of the timber sold was hemlock and silver fir. 75% of the total or 229,000,000 board feet was cedar or 54,000,000 board feet.

Short and Sweet

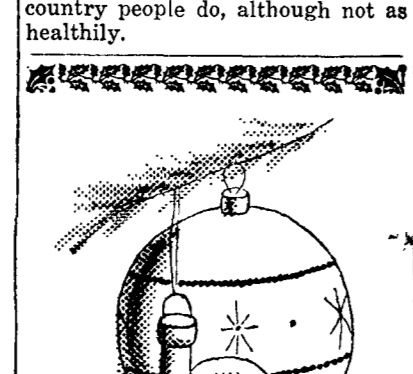
Health authorities tell us that the muscles of the legs are the body's "second heart"; that all other things being equal, leg muscles which are well-developed from much walking are as indicative of a long life ahead as a sound heart.

We are told that walking will not reduce a person's weight, but will keep them from coming back once they have been lost by other means. A normal brisk walk of a mile or two does not make the walker hungry, and it is an observable truth that habitual walkers are characteristically not overweight.

It has been recorded that a fairly long stride, at a fairly rapid pace, puts less weight on the feet, and is easier and less tiring than a slow walking speed. This is a difficult art to practice on crowded city streets, although it is estimated that city people, because of their "extra steps" up and down curbs, around sidewalk obstacles, to avoid bumping people, to beat traffic lights, actually walk more than country people do, although not as healthily.
