Welcome New Volunteers

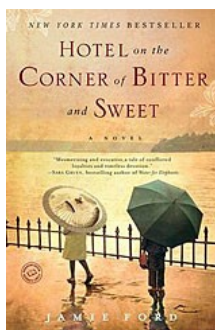

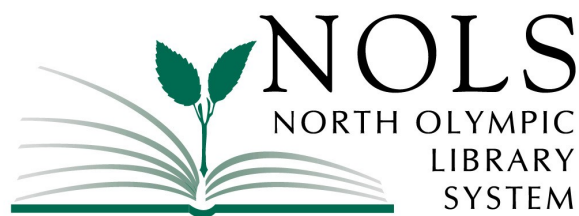
