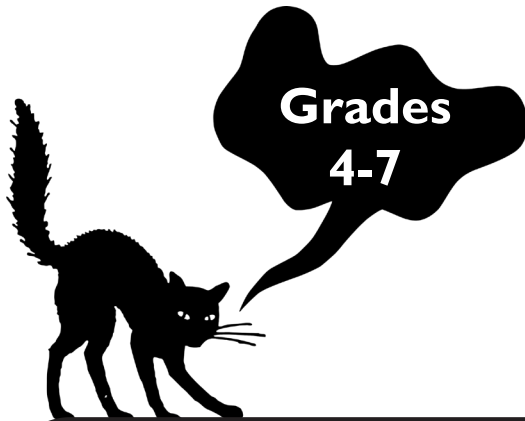


# Two-Sentence Spooky Story Contest, October 1-24
