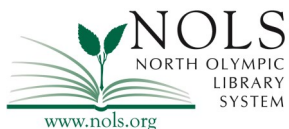

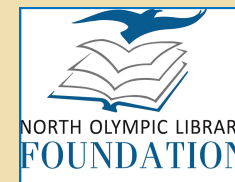

Local artists of all ages and experience levels are welcome to submit design proposals.

## About the ART CART Project

Seven beautiful wooden book carts are being decommissioned from the NOLS fleet. They await transformation to exciting new identities—and ultimately, new homes!

Artists are invited to submit design proposals to re-decorate one of these book cart beauties to meet their artistic vision. (*See Project Guidelines.*)

Re-decorated ART CARTS will be on display all around the North Olympic Library System from October through December.

ART CARTS will be auctioned during a fun library event in early 2016.

Proceeds will benefit NOLS' **Libraries on the Move** project.

### PROJECT GUIDELINES:

The blank-canvas book carts can be viewed at any NOLS library.

All artistic mediums will be considered.

Finished carts must retain their essential “bookcartness;” that is, they must be able to hold items, and retain their wheels. (Bumpers may be removed.)

The natural beauty of unpainted wood must remain prominent in the finished product.

Minor alterations, such as holes and plugs, are allowed. (Please describe in proposal.)

Artists will be notified by July 1, 2015 if their proposal has been accepted.\*

Upon acceptance, artists are responsible for:

- Picking up the cart at the nearest NOLS branch (if available), or in Port Angeles.
- Cleaning and embellishing it with art per the proposal.
- Returning the finished cart to the Port Angeles Main Library by September 30, 2015.
