Gingerbread


Stir a bowl of ginger bread (make stirring motion)

Gingerbread Playdough

Ingredients

- 1 cup flour
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 cup water
- 2 tbsp vegetable oil
- 1 tbsp cinnamon
- 2 tsp ginger
- 1 tsp nutmeg
- 1 tsp cloves

Instructions

Mix all the dry ingredients in a medium saucepan. Add water and oil, mix well. Heat over low-medium heat, stirring until it forms into a dough. Remove from heat and saucepan. Place on wax paper until it cools enough to handle. Once cooled, knead until smooth.
