Re: National Bestselling Author Jamie Ford to Present at NOLS

Acclaimed novelist Jamie Ford will join the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) virtually on Saturday, May 21 at 2pm to present *Racebending: Adventures in a Bi-Cultural World*. Ford will discuss an early example of cultural appropriation and assimilation when his great-grandfather changed his name from Min Chung to William Ford and the generational ripple effect that had on his family. He'll discuss why finding the truth in historical fiction is so important and how he came to write about subjects so close to his personal past and future.

Ford's debut, *Hotel on the Corner of Bitter and Sweet*, spent two years on the *New York Times* bestseller list and won the Asian/Pacific American Award for Literature. His second book, Songs of Willow Frost, was also a national bestseller. His novel *Love and Other Consolation Prizes* was published in 2017. Jamie's most recent novel, *The Many Daughters of Afong Moy*, will be published in June 2022.
