Pickleball is a fun sport for all ages that combines many elements of tennis, badminton and ping-pong. Invented on Bainbridge Island in 1965, pickleball has quickly grown in popularity. It's a great way to get exercise, satisfy a competitive urge, or just play with friends and family.

There are several places to play pickleball in Clallam County. If there's not a court in your area, try to set a new record for most hits back and forth without stopping, or practice your hand-eye coordination skills.
