Fostering Readers program for grades K-3 at Sequim Branch Library

Program creates positive experiences for new readers.

The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) is offering a new literacy program called Fostering Readers, designed to keep children excited about reading as they learn how to read by themselves. Students in K-3rd grades and caregivers can come to the Sequim Branch Library from 3-4pm on the third Saturday of each month, September 17, October 15 and November 19 to participate.

Each session focuses on creating joy around reading and building personal connections to storytelling. Kids can listen to a read aloud, do related arts and crafts activities, talk about stories together, and choose their own library books to take home. Caregivers must be present in the library during the program, but are not required to engage in the activities.
