The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) is teaming up with WorkSource Clallam to offer free computer classes. Participants can attend one or multiple classes to brush up on computer skills or learn how to use the computer for the first time.

Content will be based on the needs and interest of attendees and can range from how to use a mouse to how to build an Excel spreadsheet, and much more.
