Fourth graders can sign up now for Story Quest, a free, four-day winter break program at the Port Angeles Main Library, 2210 S. Peabody St.

Space is limited, and advance registration is required at NOLS.org/storyquest.

Once registered, participants should visit the front desk of the Port Angeles Main Library to pick up their free copy of “Legends of Lotus Island: The Guardian Test” by Christina Soontornvat to read on their own before Story Quest begins. During the program, attendees will discuss the book and take part in a tabletop role-playing game.

Story Quest Schedule

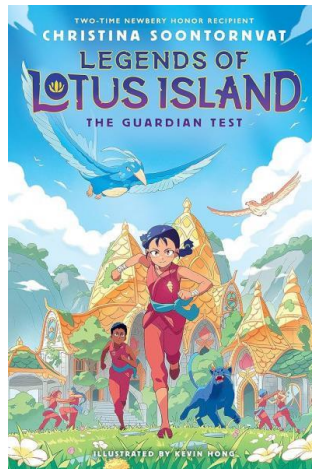
- **Monday, Dec. 30**, 10am-12pm: Book discussion and character creation.

- **Thursday, Jan. 2**, 10am-12pm: Mini-figure painting.
- **Friday, Jan. 3**, 10am-2pm: Extended hours session with tabletop campaign on the Santipap Islands and a free pizza lunch.
