The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) is continuing its popular Jigsaw Puzzle Contest on the second Saturday of each month at the Port Angeles Main Library, 2210 S. Peabody St. On Jan. 11 and Feb. 8, the contest begins at 10 a.m. The start time changes to 10:30 a.m. on March 8, April 12, May 10 and June 14. Race the clock and other teams at the two-hour timed event.

Teams of up to four people will be provided with a 500-piece jigsaw puzzle. Prizes are awarded to the team that finishes the puzzle first. If no puzzles are completed during the contest, the team with the fewest pieces remaining will be declared the winner. The puzzles are in a variety of designs, so teams can come back and try a different puzzle at each contest.

Adults, teens and children age 10 and older are invited to compete. Bring your own team or join up with others at the event.
