The Sequim Library will host a series of free programs for children and families before and during Spring Break, offering hands-on activities that encourage creativity and problem-solving.

Events will take place at the Sequim Library Temporary Location, 609 W. Washington St., and are designed for school-aged children, with adult supervision required for children under age 9. All materials are provided.

Friday, March 21, 5 to 6 p.m., families can participate in “Escape from the Wizard’s Workshop,” a pen-and-paper escape room game. Families will work together to solve puzzles designed for ages 5 to 8.

Saturday, March 29, 2:30 to 3:30 p.m., children can use their imaginations to construct unique creations at “Spring Break Build It! with LEGO.”

Thursday, April 3, 3:30 to 4:30 p.m., “Spring Break STEAM: Paper Circuit Art” will introduce children ages 6 and up to simple electronics. Participants will create a two- or three-dimensional artwork that lights up. No prior knowledge of electronics is required.
