Registration is open at [NOLS.org/events](https://nols.org/events) for a free spring break camp for ages 10-12, hosted by the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) in partnership with Peninsula College. Tweens can bring their ideas to life with basic coding skills at “[Spring into Coding: Scratch Quest Creators](#),” from 9 a.m. to noon Monday, March 30, through Wednesday, April 1, at the Port Angeles Main Library, 2210 S. Peabody St.

Attendees will be introduced to basic coding concepts through storytelling and game design using Scratch, a kid-friendly visual programming platform. Campers practice problem solving, creativity and collaboration as they build a project from idea to a playable final version of their own digital quest.

Space is limited and registration is required. Camp begins before the library opens to the public and staff will greet campers at drop off. Peninsula College created the curriculum and will provide instruction.
