On Wednesday, July 27, the North Olympic Library System invites you to discover the science and history of flight with the Museum of Flight at the Sequim Middle School Cafeteria (301 W. Hendrickson) at 10:30 am and the Port Angeles Library at 2:00 pm. The Museum of Flight's collection includes a flapping-winged bird, kites, parachutes, gliders, stomp rockets, and many others.

The Museum of Flight's appearances are presented in conjunction with *One World, Many Stories*, the North Olympic Library System's annual Summer Reading program for young people of all ages, which runs through Saturday, August 6 at all four NOLS libraries: Port Angeles, Sequim, Clallam Bay and Forks. Besides enjoying books and reading, participants will be eligible for prizes, including a grand prize.

In Port Angeles, safety considerations limit attendance for these performances. Arrive early to ensure a seat. Passes will be handed out in the library prior to the performance on a first-come, first-served basis.
