Beginners and veteran gardeners alike can always benefit from great ideas about preparing the garden for winter. In return, the well-rested and fortified garden yields more with less effort.

Many will remember Leilani from Rainshadow Nursery in downtown Sequim, which she owned and operated for ten years. Today she indulges her passion for plants by growing hanging baskets, annuals and perennials, and selling greenhouse kits from her business, the SunBaked Greenhouse. She also does estate gardening and speaks on garden subjects, most recently at the 2011 Northwest Flower and Garden Show in Seattle.

A longtime Sequim resident, Leilani's educational and vocational path started in Alaska and included winemaking in Wenatchee, working at Molbak's in Seattle, and obtaining a degree in ornamental horticulture from Washington State University in Pullman.
