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Re: *Transition Yourself: Finding Your Work Path in Hard Times* at the Port Angeles Library

On Wednesday, October 26 and Thursday, October 27 the Port Angeles Library is offering a free workshop series for people who are unemployed, under-employed, or who want to make a career change. The sessions will be held from 10am to 12pm and 1pm to 3pm on each day, with lunch provided.

The four consecutive two-hour sessions explore the psychological aspects of job loss, finding a job in tough times, and how to make a transition back to work or into self-employment. Workshop facilitator Susan K. Wilson administers the successful *Transition Yourself* program at the Port Townsend Library. "Finding a job today is vastly different from just 3 or 4 years ago," states Wilson, "the *Transition Yourself* workshop will address the new world of job seeking, along with budgeting and resources, applications, letters and resumes, interviewing and career planning".

Pre-registration and participation in all four sessions are required. The registration deadline is Friday, October 21.
