Re: Book discussion of **Mrs. Dalloway** by Virginia Woolf at the Sequim Branch Library

Mrs. Dalloway by Virginia Woolf will be discussed at 3pm on Saturday, January 14 at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System.

Mrs. Dalloway remains one of Virginia Woolf's best-known novels. Set in post-World War I England, and written in Woolf's classic stream-of-consciousness prose, the book details a day in the life of Clarissa Dalloway as she prepares for, and then hosts, a dinner party. Although the novel covers only one day, Woolf uses her literary genius to cover a lifetime as she unravels and then exposes the mysteries of human personality. This intricate character study offers no easy answers, however. Instead, it may be telling us that, at our essence, we are all unknowable, even to ourselves.
