**Re:** *Housing: Renting, Owning, Evictions, and Foreclosures* Program at North Olympic Library System Branches

The Port Angeles Main Library and Forks branch of the North Olympic Library System will host informational programs focused on tenants' and homeowners' rights. The programs will be held on the following dates:

Wednesday, May 23 from 6 – 8pm at the Port Angeles Main Library  
Tuesday, May 29 from 10am – noon at the Port Angeles Main Library  
Tuesday, June 5, from 6:30pm – 7:30pm at the Forks Branch.

If you, or someone you know, might be facing foreclosure or eviction, this program will provide essential information on your rights and what processes must be followed by financial institutions and landlords. Veteran attorney with the Northwest Justice Project, Steve Robins, will facilitate the program. Robins states, "Homeowners and renters have protected rights under Washington law. Homeowners can take advantage of the Washington Foreclosure

Mediation Program and renters cannot be evicted without proper notice and the right to a judicial hearing.”

Northwest Justice Project is a not-for-profit statewide law firm that provides pro-bono civil legal assistance and representation to qualifying people and communities throughout Washington.

The programs are free, and open to the public.
