The *Own the Night* summer reading program provides a safe and free entertainment option for teens on Friday nights through the summer. Members of the Young Adult Advisory Group say teens want the Library to be a place not only for learning, but also a community gathering place where they can be with their friends. All movies are shown under the terms of a licensing agreement through which the North Olympic Library System can hold public showings of selected titles. On movie nights only the meeting room and lobby of the Sequim Library will be open. Staff will supervise the event and movie-type refreshments will be provided.
