Starting on Thursday, July 5, at 5:00pm at the Forks Branch of the North Olympic Library System, teens ages 13 and up can sit back, relax, and enjoy pizza at the first of 2 bi-weekly movies to be shown for the *Own The Night* Summer Reading Program. Movies all have a “night” theme and are appropriate for teens aged 13.

The movie selections are: Thursday, July 5, *I Am Number Four*; and Thursday, July 19, *Super 8*.

The goal of this program is to provide a safe and free entertainment option for teens on alternate Thursday nights through the month of July. Teens want the Library to be a place not only for learning, but also a community gathering place where they can be with their friends. All movies are shown under the terms of a licensing agreement through which the North Olympic Library System can hold public showings of selected titles. Staff will supervise the event and pizza will be provided.
