On Saturday, September 20, learn, create, and connect at the North Olympic Library System's (NOLS) *Second Annual Skill Share Fair*— a free community expo at the Port Angeles Main Library for learning and teaching practical, handy skills that help foster a more resilient and sustainable community.

The 2014 Fair kicks off at 11am with a special seed saving presentation. Then, from noon until 3pm, skilled presenters from local business and organizations will be inside the library discussing their experiences, answering questions, and offering demonstrations of skills, including: rain garden installation; felting, quilting and spinning; bike and home repair; cooking and home brewing; recycled art and jewelry making, as well as composting and emergency preparedness. Participants who visit multiple stations will be eligible to enter a prize raffle for useful DIY gear donated by Swain's General Store, Airport Garden Center and others.
