Re: Sequim and Port Angeles libraries present "Bee-Bots" program from Olympia's Children's Museum

On Tuesday, July 15, as part of *Fizz Boom Read*, the North Olympic Library System's annual summer reading program for young people, educators from Olympia's Hands On Children's Museum will present "Buzzing Bee-Bots." The program will be offered at the Sequim Middle School Cafeteria at 301 W. Hendrickson at 10:30am, and at the Port Angeles Library at 2pm. Museum educators will discuss the science behind bumblebee behavior and provide materials to design and build a robot bee that moves with a vibrating motor. Bee-Bots will only be available for use during the program.

Fizz Boom Read runs through Saturday, August 2 at all four NOLS libraries: Port Angeles, Sequim, Clallam Bay and Forks. In addition to enjoying books and reading, participants are eligible for prizes, including a grand prize.
