On Monday, July 14, at 11am, the Forks Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) will present *Can-Do Robots!* Participants will enjoy funny stories about robots then build their own “Mr. Potato-Head”-style robots from recycled materials, using magnets to create moveable parts.
