Let the exploring begin! Walkie-talkie two-way radios are now available for checkout at all branches of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS). The radios, which patrons may borrow for three weeks, are perfect for camping, hiking, hunting, and other fun adventures.

Each radio will operate for up to 10 hours, and comes with rechargeable batteries and a charging station. With a range of up to 35 miles, NOLS two-way radios allow you to roam widely without losing touch. Additional safety features include a built-in flashlight, weatherproof design to prevent dust and moisture from interfering with functionality, and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) channels to help keep you alerted to extreme weather conditions like flash floods or blizzards. The radios also come equipped with an optional silent vibrating ringer.

To check-out a set of walkie-talkies, stop by your nearest NOLS library location, or place a hold by visiting the library catalog at www.nols.org and entering the search term, "Walkie Talkie."
