Subject: Videography Workshops for Young Adults

This winter the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) will offer a three-part videography series for young adults between the ages of 12 and 18. Workshops will take place from 4pm to 6pm on Tuesday, February 2, February 9, and February 16. The workshops will be led by professional photographer and videographer C. Woodrow French, and will take place in the Sequim Branch Library meeting room. Participants are encouraged to bring their personal cameras to each session, however the library will also provide a limited number of devices for use during the workshops.

On February 2, participants will focus on pre-visualization, *Creative Commons* music, and green screen operation. The second session on February 9 will explore various filming techniques, and the final session on February 16 will be devoted to post-production editing and uploading projects to YouTube.

All sessions in the series are free. Space is limited, however, and pre-registration is required.
