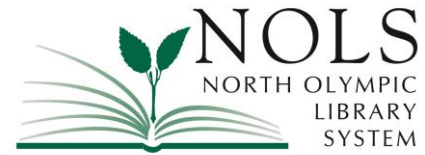

What is brain research telling us about storytelling? How far off is holographic technology, really? How can building design effect how we interact with the dying, and how we experience the process of death? What can skin color really tell us? Take on these and other big questions this February at TEDxPortAngelesLibraryLive.

TEDxPortAngelesLibraryLive will bring one day of the TED2016 Conference to the Port Angeles Main Library beginning at 1pm on Thursday, February 18. Watch thought-provoking talks on a wide range of topics, from social issues to science breakthroughs, interspersed with a live, simulcast feed from the TED2016 Conference in Vancouver. This event will take place in the Raymond Carver Room at the Port Angeles Main Library, and is free and open to the public. Stop in for one video, one hour, or more. The theme for TED2016 is Dreams: the greatest dreams we are capable of dreaming. If you like, adjourn to the Library Living Room between sessions and begin the discussion; these are ideas worth spreading.

About TEDx (x = independently organized event)

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TEDx event, TED Talks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection. These local, self-organized events are branded TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED

Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)

About TED

TED is a nonprofit organization devoted to Ideas Worth Spreading, usually in the form of short, powerful talks (18 minutes or fewer) delivered by today's leading thinkers and doers. Many of these talks are given at TED's annual conference in Vancouver, British Columbia, and made available, free, on TED.com. TED speakers have included Bill Gates, Jane Goodall, Elizabeth Gilbert, Sir Richard Branson, Nandan Nilekani, Philippe Starck, Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala, Sal Khan and Daniel Kahneman.
