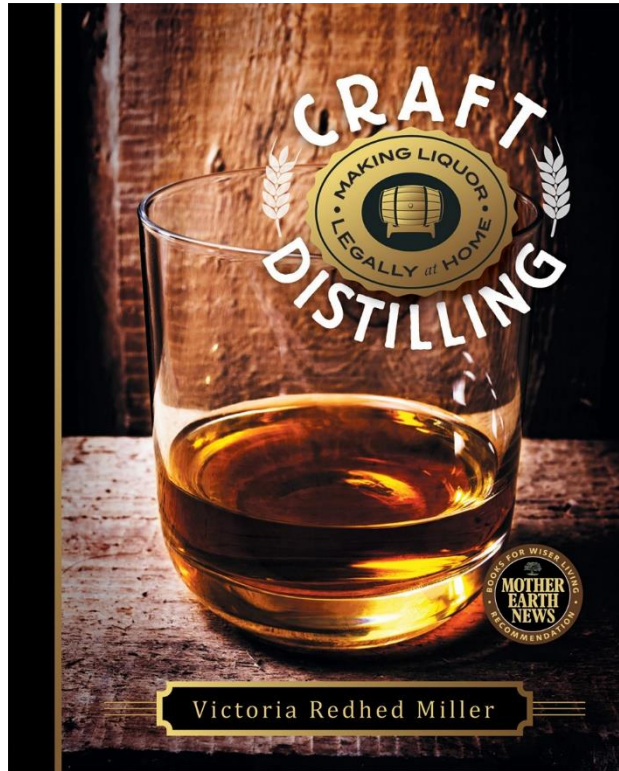
For all fine-food and –drink enthusiasts, small-batch home distilling is a must-try experiment. Distillation expert and author Victoria Redhed Miller will venture beyond home-brewed beer and wine during her presentation, *Craft Distilling*, at 6pm on Thursday, May 19, at the Port Angeles Main Library.

Distilled spirits are more complicated than home brewing, but within reach of a prepared enthusiast. In this free event, Miller will introduce audience members to legal facts important for hobby distillers and discuss the principles of distillation. Learn the basics to get started making quality gin, whiskey, vodka, tequila, or rum on a small scale.

Self-reliance enthusiast Victoria Redhed Miller grew up in Seattle and now lives with her husband on their off-grid farm in the foothills near Sequim. She writes and blogs about homesteading, and speaks at events around the country.
