The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) will present *TEDxSequimLibrary*, an independently organized TED Talks event, at 6pm on Tuesday, June 21 at the Sequim Branch Library. This free event will take place in the library meeting room and feature four thought-provoking talks that will explore the sea, air, and earth. Stop in for one video or more; if you like, stay for the conversations between each talk.

The evening's talks will feature:

- Artist Janet Echelman: Taking imagination seriously
- Conservation Photographer Thomas Peschak: Dive into an ocean photographer's world
- Ocean Scientist Laura Robinson: The secrets I find on the mysterious ocean floor
- Author Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie: The danger of a single story

About TEDx (x = independently organized event)

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TEDx event, TED Talks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection. These local, self-organized events are branded TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)

About TED

TED is a nonprofit organization devoted to Ideas Worth Spreading, usually in the form of short, powerful talks (18 minutes or fewer) delivered by today's leading thinkers and doers. Many of these talks are given at TED's annual conference in Vancouver, British Columbia, and made available, free, on TED.com.
