The first of three performances will take place at 6pm on Monday, June 27 at the Port Angeles Main Library, followed by a show at 10:30am on Tuesday, June 28 at the Sequim High School auditorium, and another at 6pm on Tuesday at the Rainforest Arts Center in Forks.

About the show

Anansi is a clever, witty, foolish, and greedy little spider who loves to eat but hates to work. Watch what happens as Anansi meets a river goblin, fights a chimpanzee, and plays a trick on his entire village—this is a show not to be missed!

Summer Reading at NOLS

The 2016 Summer Reading Program, taking place June 20 through August 20, offers an array of events and incentive-based reading programs to encourage children to read during their summer vacations. Research shows that children who do not read during the summer lose up to a month of instructional knowledge they learned the previous year—what is known as the “summer slide.” Library summer reading programs have been shown to help alleviate the “summer slide” by providing access to materials, enrichment activities, and encouraging kids to continue reading.
