

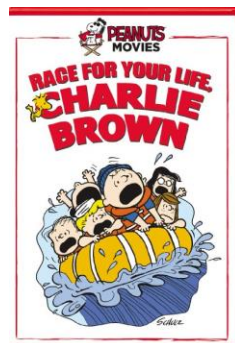

Re: *Summer Movie Series* at the Sequim Branch Library

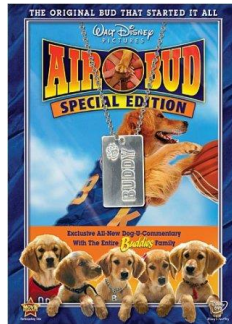

The series will provide out-of-the-sun family entertainment, snacks, and fun movie trivia at an affordable price—free!

The series kicks-off **July 1** with a screening of “Race for your Life, Charlie Brown.” The Peanuts gang goes to summer camp where they face more challenges than they can shake a tent pole at! Tug o’ war, sack racing and physical training at dawn, Charlie Brown and his pals face a group called the Bullies who are determined to beat our friends at everything. This 1977 G-rated film is loaded with fun and excitement.

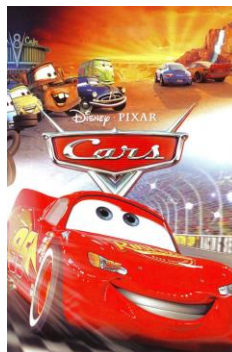

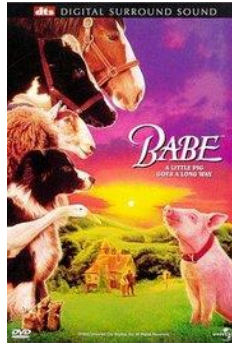

“Cars,” winner of the 2006 Golden Globe Award for Best Animated Feature Film, will continue the series on **July 15**. The G-rated movie depicts hotshot rookie race car Lightning McQueen who is living life in the fast lane until he hits a detour on his way to the most important race of his life. Stranded in Radiator Springs, a forgotten town on the old Route 66, he meets Sally, Mater, Doc Hudson and a variety of quirky characters who help him discover that there's more to life than trophies and fame.



On **July 22**, take your family to see “Babe,” a G-rated 1995 Australian-American film that tells the story of a pig who wants to be a sheepdog and befriends and learns about all the other creatures on the farm. He becomes special friends with one of the sheepdogs, Fly. With Fly's help, and Farmer Hoggett's intuition, Babe embarks on a career in sheepherding with some surprising results.



The final feature of the Summer Movie Series will be “Racing Stripes” on **July 29**. A 2005 PG-rated movie, “Racing Stripes” tells the story of an abandoned zebra who grows up believing he is a racehorse. With the help of his barnyard friends and a teenage girl Stripes sets out to achieve his dream of racing with thoroughbreds.

The 2016 Summer Reading Program will take place at all NOLS libraries through Saturday, August 20, and provides an array of educational, cultural and incentive-based programs to encourage children to continue reading and learning during their summer vacations.
