Research shows that children who do not read during their summer vacations lose up to a month of instructional knowledge learned during the previous year in what is known as the “summer slide.” Library summer reading programs have been shown to help alleviate the “summer slide” by providing access to materials, enrichment activities, and encouraging kids to read.
