The North Olympic Library System has recently promoted the Port Angeles Main Library Manager, Noah Glaude, to the position of Assistant Library Director. The Assistant Library Director's position has been vacant since July 2014, when then Assistant Director Margaret Jakubcin was promoted to Library Director.

The promotion was the conclusion of a long and exacting national recruitment process, with Glaude selected as the best fit for NOLS' administrative and leadership needs. "Noah's skills and abilities have been well demonstrated during his time at NOLS, and his familiarity with NOLS' operations and initiatives make him the perfect person for the job," said Library Director Margaret Jakubcin. Glaude was originally hired by NOLS in 2011, with previous library experience at the University of Washington. At NOLS he has been responsible for the successful implementation of numerous projects including: streamlining circulation efficiencies and workflows, improving statistical collection and reporting, and managing remodel projects of the Carver Meeting

Room, and the Youth Services and Public Computing areas of the Port Angeles Main Library. Glaude has been a member of the NOLS Management Team since February of 2014.

"The Port Angeles Friends of the Library board was most excited to hear of the new and well deserved position for Noah," said Julie Fisher, PAFOL Chair. "He has been a wonderful resource for the Friends board, and such a pleasure to work with. His intelligence, dedication and influence will now reach much further."

"During my five years at NOLS I've enjoyed working on a wide-range of fun and exciting projects, introducing new services, and assisting the public directly in various roles," said Glaude. "As Assistant Library Director, I'm looking forward to further developing my relationship with NOLS and the community, and continuing to support both however I can."
