The Chuck Easton-Rex Rice Quintet will perform at 6:30pm on Friday, October 7, at the Sequim branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) during the first Friday ArtWalk and opening reception for the new Art in the Library show, featuring the work of local photographer Ken Dvorak. An artist reception will take place at 6pm, followed by live jazz.

### **About the band**

At 6:30pm, the Chuck Easton-Rex Rice Quintet will play select jazz tunes from the 1940's through the 1960's, with Chuck Easton on saxophone, Rex Rice on trombone, Mark Schecter on piano, Dirk Anderson on bass, and Tom Svornich on drums. With a front line of tenor and trombone, the quintet can deliver a small-group rendering of some of the big band hits of the swing era.

### **Art in the Library**

The newest Art in the Library exhibit features the black and white photography of Sequim's Ken Dvorak, and will be on display from October 7 through February 1 at the Sequim Branch Library. Dvorak is a former teacher and recent Montana transplant. In April 2016, he joined the Blue Whole Gallery in downtown Sequim.
