Kindergarten Storytime for children between the ages of four and six will resume at 1:30pm on Tuesday, October 18, at the Clallam Bay branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS). Storytimes at NOLS feature rhymes, music, crafts, dancing, and the best books for young children.
