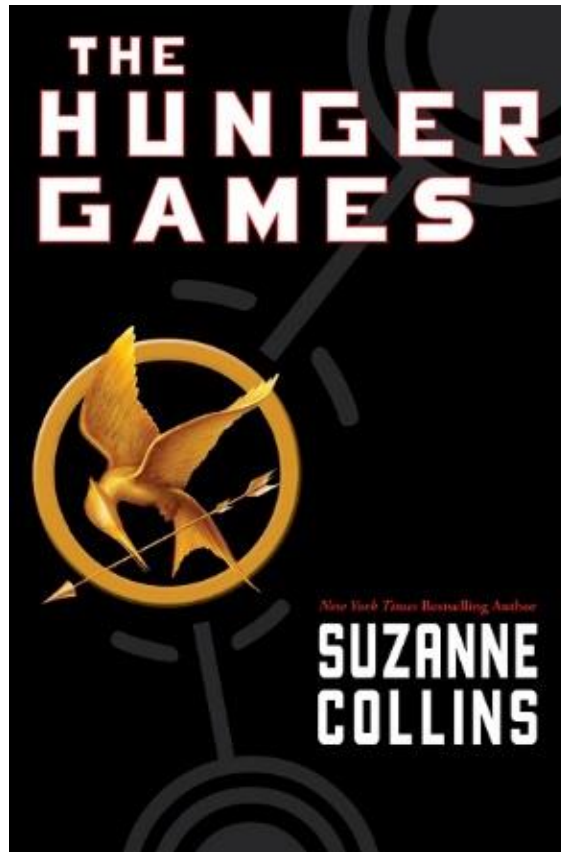
About the book
