This stirring memoir tells the remarkable story of Robyn Davidson, a young woman who leaves her life in the city to make a solo trek across almost 2,000 miles of sprawling Australian desert. Accompanied by only her dog and four unpredictable camels, she sets off on a life-changing journey of self-discovery. Along the way, she meets National Geographic photographer Rick Smolan, who begins to chronicle her voyage. Author Cheryl Strayed calls it “an unforgettably powerful book.”
