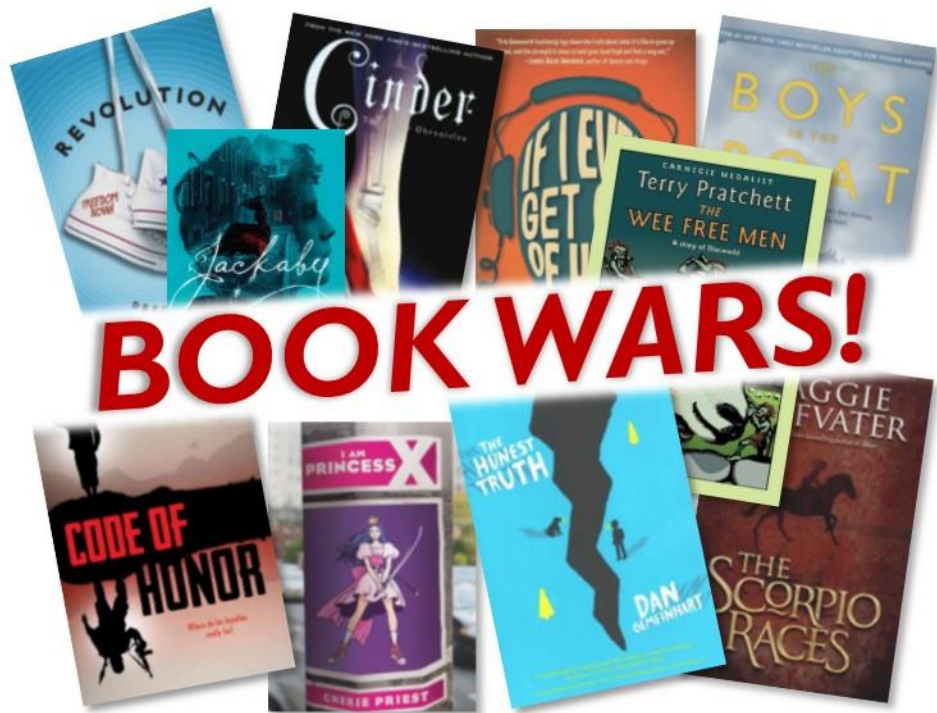
About the program
