Re: Book discussion of *If the Oceans Were Ink* by Carla Power at the Sequim Branch Library

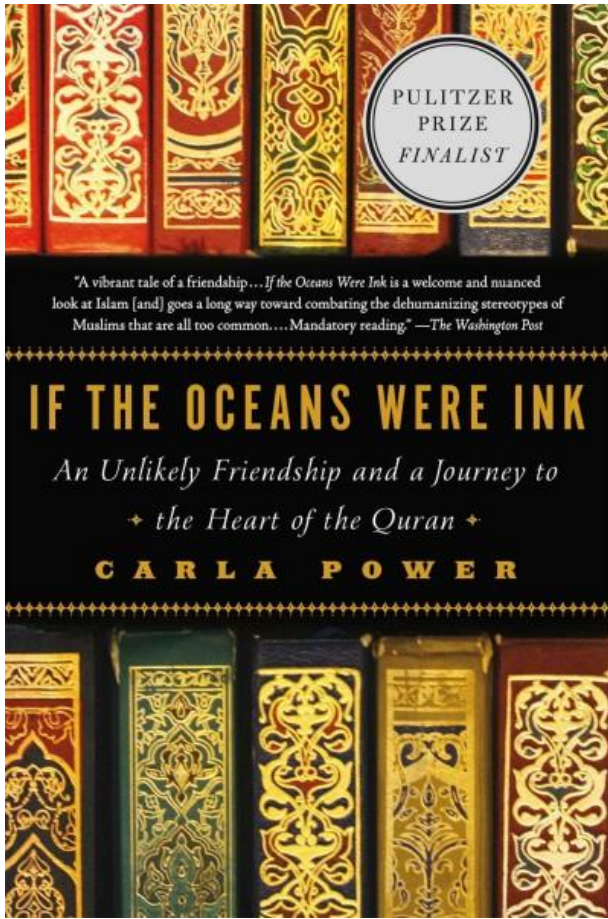
