Re: Book discussion of “The Painter” by Peter Heller at the Sequim Branch Library

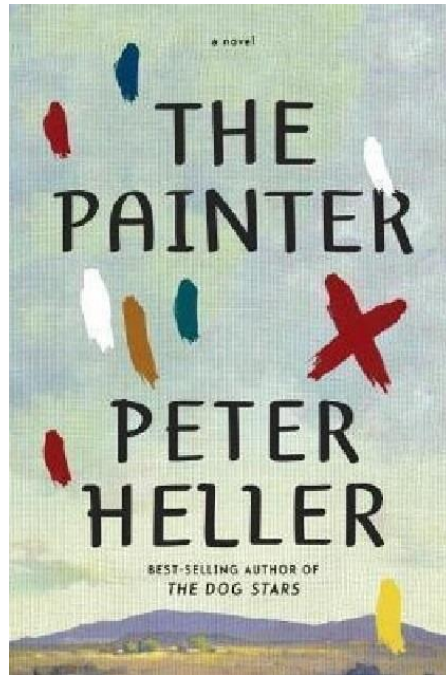
“The Painter” by Peter Heller will be discussed at 3pm on Saturday, April 8, at the Sequim Branch of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS).
