Research shows that creative play is important in the development of reading and critical thinking skills. Libraries from around the country offer programs using LEGO® bricks to encourage young people and families to play and build together.

LEGO® bricks and creations will remain in the library at the conclusion of each program. All ages are welcome, though parents or caregivers are asked to accompany all children under 8 years-old. All materials will be provided.
