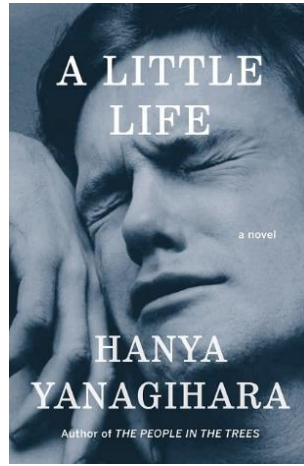

Although Jude is a successful litigator, his full background is murky, though what we do learn about it is horrific...This profoundly disturbing book is about pain and compulsion, secrets and betrayals, sexuality and loss - but, finally, about friendship.”
