Why *can't* you trust that link, this video, an article shared by a friend or family member? What is "truthiness"? How do you identify bias?


Media Literacy workshop attendees will learn how to examine and analyze their information sources, and leave more confident of their ability to find reliable, evidence-based information, and to avoid being "faked out" by false or fabricated news.

What is Media Literacy?

Today's media landscape and technologies mean that misinformation or disinformation can be widely shared and disseminated, accidentally or purposefully, regardless of the facts. The

number of sources and formats make it difficult to consistently choose unbiased, accurate outlets. A Media Literate person can analyze the relationships among media, audiences, information, and power to decode where truth lies within a story.
