Participants are to meet at Slip Point Lighthouse at the end of Frontier Street in Clallam Bay.

Wear sturdy shoes that will not slip off easily and bring your favorite lab assistant (an adult) with you to help in your exploration. For youth ages 5 - 7 and a caregiver.

The theme for the 2017 Summer Reading Program is *Build a Better World*. This summertime celebration, which encourages children to keep reading during the summer break from school, features a reading challenge and a multitude of events for all ages. Research shows that children who do not read during the summer experience "summer slide" and may lose up to a month of the instructional knowledge they gained during the previous school year. Library summer reading programs have been shown to help alleviate the "summer slide" by providing

access to books, enrichment activities, and encouraging young people to keep reading. The Summer Reading Program runs through Saturday, August 19.
