As part of the North Olympic Library System's annual Summer Reading Program, Hank Gibson will be presenting Permaculture in the Garden at the Port Angeles Main Library of the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) on Monday, July 17, at 6:30pm.

"Permaculture is a design system for creating sustainable human environments."—Bill Mollison. This presentation will provide an overview of permaculture, including a brief history and a detailed review of key ethics and principles, as well as an insightful exploration of permaculture sites around the world. A wide range of possibilities, with scales ranging from small urban backyards up to large acreage sites will be discussed. Gibson will also include an introduction to edible forest gardens and community resilience food growing projects with educational opportunities for children. This program is offered in theme with the NOLS Grows Seed Library. NOLS Grows offers free vegetable seeds along with growing and seed saving education to anyone interested in participating.

Hank Gibson is a Permaculture Architect, combining his passion for design and his knowledge as a certified permaculture instructor. He has been interested in permaculture ideology for over 35 years, and has been actively involved as a practitioner and educator for the past decade. a strong advocate for sustainable local community systems of all types, having served as a member of numerous regional organizations including; Port Angeles Farmers Market, Sustainable Peninsula, Clallam Food Policy Council, Port Angeles Community Gardens, Transition Port Angeles, and WSU Master Gardeners.
